Perspective is a technique that creates the illusion of three-dimensional space on a two-dimensional surface, resulting in much more realistic artworks. This art element often instills a new confidence in young artists as it can feel like a big step toward understanding why their drawings may look "flat". Even if someone isn't trying to make their art look realistic, perspective is still an important concept to understand because it directly affects the sense of space in the piece. Once you gain this understanding you can intentionally use perspective in a way that creates a unique sense of space that isn't necessarily realistic. #### A Timeless Tribute to Persian Heritage: Oil Painting of the Faravahar

We are proud to showcase this remarkable oil painting at Noor that brings to life one of the most iconic symbols of ancient Persian culture—the Faravahar. This masterfully rendered artwork recreates the image as it might have once appeared carved into the stone walls of Persepolis, the ceremonial capital of the Achaemenid Empire. With meticulous detail, the artist captures both the texture of ancient stone and the majesty of Persian symbolism. Set against a dramatic sky and fractured stone façade, the artwork evokes both the endurance and fragility of cultural memory. The surrounding motifs, from floral carvings to broken architectural forms, further enrich the visual narrative—bridging the ancient past with modern reverence. Did You Know?

Faravahar is a winged symbol deeply rooted in Zoroastrianism, one of the world's oldest known religions. The Faravahar is often interpreted as a representation of the human soul and its journey toward enlightenment and righteousness. The figure typically holds a ring, believed to represent loyalty or eternity, and is flanked by outstretched wings divided into three sections, symbolizing the Zoroastrian creed: "Good Thoughts, Good Words, Good Deeds."
